### EDUCATION MANAGEMENT BRIEF

This is the largest programme of Windle International Uganda. It involves actual administration of schools including hiring and remuneration of teachers at pre-primary, primary and post primary institutions, Infrastructure development within the settlements

Windle also supports the learners and schools with scholastic as well as learning and instructional materials which include; chalk, textbooks, scheme books, pens and furniture for schools under WIU within the settlements.

### WIU AREAS OF OPERATION:

Windle operates in 12 Districts of; Isingiro, Kamwenge, Kyegegwa, Hoima, Kiryandongo, Adjumani, Moyo, Yumbe, Lamwo and Arua with Kampala as the Headquarter.

The office locations are distributed as follows:

- **South West:** Nakivale, Oruchinga, Kyaka II & Rwamwanja
- **Mid-Western:** Kiryandongo and Kyangwali
- **Northern Uganda:** Adjumani, Palorina and Palabek
- **West Nile:** Rhino Camp, Imvepi and Bidibidi.

There are over 2,922 fulltime staff including teachers across the country.

- Target beneficiaries are both Refugees and members of the host communities.
- Windle supports 587 Schools including: ECD - 305, Primary – 237, Secondary 41 and 4 Vocational.

### WIU AREAS OF FOCUS

- To increase access to Education to 80%
- Improve access to secondary education through providing affordable and sustainable secondary education.
- Improve access to University education through creation of borderless Higher education/online learning.
- ICT innovation to improve quality of education.
- To Increase access to vocational education through vocationalisation of secondary education.



### EDUCATION MANAGEMENT STATUS IN WIU AREAS OF OPERATION.

Enrolment in Early Child Development (ECD) is 62,716 both Refugees and Nationals children aged 3-5 by end of 2017.

- Enrolment in Primary schools is 273,277 both Refugee and Nationals children aged 6-17.
- Enrolment in Secondary schools stands at 24,078 both Refugees and Nationals aged 14-17.
- Average attendance stands at 86% in primary schools.
- Transition from Primary to Secondary currently stands at 70%
- 1,475 classrooms so far constructed under the UNHCR/WIU partnership across the country.
- 2,277 latrines stances so far constructed under the UNHCR/WIU partnership across the country.
- 34,470 desks so far produced and delivered to schools across the country.
- 5,904 Refugees and members of the host community regularly participate in the Educational processes through PTA and SMC.
- 117 units of teachers' accommodation currently constructed.



### SCHOLARSHIP MANAGEMENT

- 15 Students are currently in UK on the Windle Masters scholarship Programme.
- 446 Students are currently on DAFI scholarship programme.
- 3,548 Students are accessing tertiary Education inside and outside the settlements
- 8 Students are on Windle University Scholarship in National Universities (3 from Acholi sub region and 5 Refugees)
- 5 Students are on individual Secondary School scholarship (4 from Adjumani and 1 from Kyaka II)
- 1,661 Students are on UNHCR Secondary School scholarships
- 263 PSNs from all settlements are currently accessing education.
