#### DISTRICTS & SETTLEMENTS OF OPERATION

#### EDUCATIONAL MANAGEMENT BRIEF

There are 32.01 fulltime stuff including touchers across the country.

Target burnfickering are both children and youth from the Refugeer and host communities.

Windle Ugunda supports 268 Schools including 106 ECD, 146 Primary schools, 12 Secundary schools, 2 Vocational Centres it 2 Community Technology Access (CTA) Centres. This is the largest programme of Windle Uganda.

It involves actual administration of schools including biring and recommended of teachers at pre-primary, primary and post primary institutions, infrastructure development within the actionness.

WIII also develops aducation infrastructure, supports the learners and achools with scholastic as well as learning and instructional materials which include, chalk, testbooks, scheme books, pens and furniture for schools under WIU within the autientation.





## EDUCATIONAL MANAGEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- Enrotment in Eurly Child Development is 62,716 both Refugees & Nationals children aged 3-5 by end of 2017.
- Enrolment in Primary schools is 273,277 both Rafuges and Nationals children aged 6-17.
- Enrolment in Soczendary at hools struck at 24,078 both.
  Refugees and Nationals aged 14-17.
- Average attendance stands at \$6% in primary schools.
- Transition from Primary to Secondary stands at 70%
- 1,475 classrooms as for constructed under the UNHCR/ WIII pertnerably agreement across the country.
- 2,277 latebas stances so for constructed under the
- UNHCR/WIU pertnamble across the country.
- 34,470 dusts so for produced and delivered to schools across the country.
- A total of 5,904 Rufugues fit members from the host community regularly participate in the Educational processes through PTA and SMC.
- A total 117 units of touchest accommodation currently constructed.
