What do you need to do? - For study in the UK

- 1. Complete and submit the application forms for **both** Windle Trust International **and** the Commonwealth Scholarships Commission.

- 2. If shortlisted for selection, attend an interview with Windle Trust International. Interviews will be held in your home country.

What do you need to do? - For Distance Learning

- Complete and submit the application forms for both Windle Trust International and the Commonwealth Scholarships Commission. - 2. If shortlisted for selection, attend an interview with Windle Trust International. Interviews will be held in your home country.
